CHAMPIONSHIP EVENTS :

Coxed Fours

Indoor Rowing

Both events will have Senior & Junior categories for Boys & Girls

COURSE & DISTANCE:

2 or 3 Lanes, Marked, **500 Meters**

CHAMPIONSHIP FORMAT:

Repechage System (the crew gets another chance for racing, even after losing the first Race) for Coxed Fours
Time Trials for Indoor Rowing

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Seniors - Bonafide School students' up to Class XII, **-born on or after 1.4.1998**

Juniors - Bonafide School students' up to Class X, **-born on or after 1.4.2001**

- Students who have appeared for Board Examinations for Class X or Class XII in this year (2017) may also participate if entries are officially confirmed by the School before the results are declared.
- Maximum 50 Entries per category in each event will be accepted on first come basis.
- All participants **MUST** know how to swim and furnish a bond signed by their parents.
- Juniors can participate in the senior events but not vice-versa.
- Original School Fee Books must be produced by each student at the time of registration.
- Original Municipal Birth Certificate will be required as proof of age.
- A Dental examination for age verification may be done for all junior participants.
- The Regatta Committee reserves the right to disallow any School/ Participant to take part in the Championship without having to assign any reason for such disqualification.

- All intellectual properties, photographs, electronic recording of the event, broadcasting of the event is absolute Domain of the Club and can be used by any person subject to the license being granted by the Club only. No sport persons or member of the Club can object to such usage by the Club or its licensee including broadcast or publication thereof.

BOATS & EQUIPMENT

All boats, oars & rowing ergo meters will be provided by The Bengal Rowing Club. Mishandling of equipment by participants may result in their disqualification from the event.

TRAINING & PRACTICE

- ◆ Free Training will be provided to all Participating School students by coaches and eminent rowers of The Bengal Rowing Club.
- ◆ **PRACTICE FOR REGISTERED ROWERS ONLY WILL BE ALLOWED FROM 1ST APRIL 2017.**
- ◆ It is mandatory for each crew having first time competitors FROM KOLKATA to have taken a minimum 15 number of Boat Outings to qualify for the races.
- ◆ **ALL ENTRIES WILL CLOSE ON SUNDAY, 30TH APRIL, 2017 AT 5 PM.**

RULES: INDOOR ROWING

Individual Event:

- ▶ All Participants are eligible to participate.
- ▶ Participants will be allowed to clock the timing.
- ▶ Fastest 3 rowers will be awarded in each category

Team:

- ▶ All participating crews of Coxed Fours event are eligible to participate.
- ▶ Each team will have 4 participants
- ▶ Reserves of the crew are also eligible to participate
- ▶ Only the fastest crew in each category will be awarded.

**Teams must report with ID cards and in racing uniform 30 minutes before the Time Trials.
Regatta Committee may change the format or any other matter at any stage of the event.
No practice will be allowed on racing days**

BOARDING, FOODING AND CONVEYANCE OF OUTSTATION TEAMS

Boarding, Fooding & Conveyance to the participants will be assisted by BRC on actual cost basis and the same should be borne by the participants.

AWARDS & PRIZES

All participants will receive Participation Certificates.
Coxes will be allotted for each race by the Regatta Committee.

Criteria and Point system for the BEST DISCIPLINED SCHOOL

1. SUBMISSION OF FORMS.

- **15** Points for submission of entry forms on or within 23rd April 2017.
- **10** Points for submission of forms on or within 30th April 2017.

➤ **NOTE:-**

All forms should be carefully filled online and all supporting documents should be enclosed.

2. PRACTICE OUTINGS.

- **2** Points for outings per day will be awarded to schools per team taking proper boat outings. If the team fails to report back within its stipulated time then the team gets only **1** Point.
- No Points will be provided for Ergometer practice but if it is observed that the participant is mishandling with the Ergometer machine then 5 Points will be deducted.

➤ **NOTE:-**

A proper outing will only be considered if the registered team takes the boat outing. If the school is represented by 2 or more team then the total points will be averaged by the number of teams.

- **5** Points will be awarded to the team which will take maximum number of boat outings in Fours.
- **4** Points will be awarded to the team which will take second maximum number of boat outings in Fours.
- **3** Points will be awarded to the team which will take third maximum number of boat outings in Fours.
- **2** Points will be awarded to the team which will take fourth maximum number of boat outings in Fours.
- **1** Points will be awarded to the team which will take fifth maximum number of boat outings in Fours.

➤ **NOTE:-**

- ✓ Every crew of the school is liable to get points if they fulfill the above clauses and in case of tie all the team will get full points.
- ✓ **Each School will maintain the chart given to them & get it signed by the Raft Master immediately after the practice and submit the same to Control office on every Sunday to facilitate the Points tabulation.**

3. DRESS CODE

- **3** Bonus points will be awarded to crew taking boat outings with uniform clothing having the School emblem on it.
- **2** Bonus points will be awarded to crew taking boat outings with uniform clothing without having the School emblem on it.
- No points will be awarded to crew taking outings without uniform clothing.

4 TEACHER'S PARTICIPATION

- **3** Points will be provided to schools if the sports teacher is present during the Teachers' Meet.
- **3** Points will be provided to schools if the sports teacher is present during the Draw.
- **3** Points will be provided to schools if the sports teacher is present during the Opening Ceremony.

➤ **NOTE:-**

In the absence of the sports teacher any other teacher from the school can represent that school with the school ID.

5. INTERFERENCE

- The regatta Committee will not accept any interference during practice sessions or during the races or during protest, other than the Team captain or a school representative (same should be teacher from that school with valid ID proof to be presented at the time of protest)
- If the school fails to abide by the above clause there will be a penalty of -50 points for that school for lodging a protest.
- The team has to deposit Rs 500 and the amount will be refunded if the protest is upheld.

6 GENERAL DISCIPLINE OF THE SCHOOL

- The general behavior & discipline of the teams at the Club premises will be monitored by 3 judges from the club having 45 points (15 X 3 Nos of Judge) and the same will be awarded according to their observations.
- The committee reserves the right to change Format, Competition rules, Time allotments, etc at their own discretion to accommodate the needs and ensure the overall success of the Championship.
- The decision of the committee is final & binding to all.
